Campaign for the Future of Higher Education

The Campaign for the Future of Higher Education (CFHE) held its fourth national gathering from January 18-20 in Sacramento, California. The meeting included a panel discussion on how to best foster community engagement in these tough times for unions, public employees, and education, featuring Jackson Potter from the Chicago Teachers Union. One of the strategies shared was “listen locally, connect globally,” connecting local concerns to national patterns of disinvestment.

The meeting also provided participants with the opportunity to discuss funding issues in higher education as well as a panel on effective uses of technology in higher education.

National AAUP Releases Report on Contingent Faculty and Governance

AAUP released the final version of its report, [The Inclusion in Governance of Faculty Members Holding Contingent Appointments](#), this week. According to *Inside Higher Education*, the “key recommendations include extending tenure-track professors' voting rights and governance body leadership opportunities to all faculty members who are primarily engaged in independent teaching or research, including adjuncts, graduate students, postdoctoral fellows and librarians; the ability to participate in evaluating other adjunct faculty (if not tenure-track faculty); and compensation for work performed outside of instruction.”
