## **Hearing on the BOR Draft Policy on Transfer and Articulation**

The Academic and Student Affairs Committee of the Board of Regents will hold an open forum on its [draft policy on Transfer and Articulation](#) (the policy begins on page 2 of the document).

The forum is open to everyone. The Faculty Advisory Committee to the Board of Regents will also make a statement in response to the draft policy.

## **February CSU-AAUP Council Meeting**

At its February 16 meeting, the CSU-AAUP Council :

- Discussed the BOR Draft Policy on Transfer and Articulation (see previous article) with Dr. Louise Feroe;
- Reviewed legislation proposed by the Higher Education Committee with the CSU-AAUP lobbyist, Betty Gallo;
- Passed a resolution in support of legislation to examine the prevalence of workplace bullying in the state of Connecticut's workforce;
- Heard from Peter Nguyen, the new Executive Director of UConn-AAUP;
- Discussed the Collective Bargaining Congress Regional Meeting that took place earlier in February;
- Heard reports from the respective chapters about campus issues including concerns about the calendar for the next academic year.
