Reform of Remedial Education

In its *Update* February 2013 newsletter, the Board of Regents reports on remedial education reform. It states that “Currently, faculty at the community colleges and the state universities are working together with support through the College Access Challenge Grant administered by the Board of Regents central office to develop the courses [college-level courses with embedded support and intensive college readiness programs].
