## CSUS BOT Proposes Tuition Increase

Facing a \$22 million deficit for next fiscal year, officials at CSUS announced that they will not be able to freeze tuition as planned and proposed a 2.5% increase. The increase represents an average increase of \$198 in tuition and fees for Connecticut residents and is expected to generate \$7.8 million in additional revenue. The Finance and Administration Committee of the BOT will vote on this increase on Thursday and it will be in front of the full BOT next week.
