House Bill Passed

At its session on April 24, the House of Representatives voted in favor of HB 5602 (File No. 457), **AN ACT EXEMPTING INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION THAT OFFER FREE COURSES TO INMATES FROM STATE CONTRACTING REQUIREMENTS.**
