Higher Ed's Remediation Bill Garnering National Attention

SB 40, *An Act Concerning College Readiness and Completion*—which was created, amended, and approved by the Higher Education and Employment Advancement Committee - is now getting some national press attention. Read the bill, as approved by the Committee, [here](#). This bill may be considered for a vote at any point before the end of the General Assembly session.

Inside Higher Education published an article, "[How to End Remediation](#)," on April 4. The article generated fifty comments, overwhelmingly in opposition to the proposal. *U.S. News & World Reports* also published an article, "[Connecticut May Let College Students Skip Remedial Classes](#)," on April 6.

CSU-AAUP has made suggestions for further amendments, and our organization continues to try to influence the final language of this bill.
